


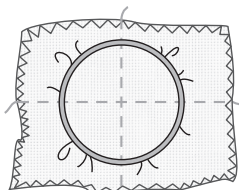

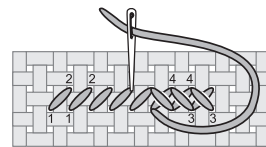
Tape 3 mm (30 cm)

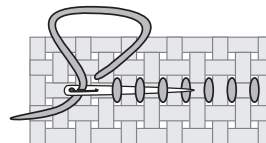

Please read the manual to avoid mistakes!

- The embroidery can be started from any part of the drawing after determining the distance from the center in cells (**T2**).
- A hank of wool is one and indivisible thread (**T3**). Colors of threads are indicated in **T1**.
- The embroidery is done (**T1**):
-  - with 3-strand cross-stitch,
-  - with 1-strand stitch,

- The work will look good if all upper stitches are inclined in one direction (**T4**).
- Avoid knots. Hide the thread ends under the stitches of the reverse side (**T5**).
- Iron the finished embroidery from the reverse side.
- Using the needle take the ends of the tape on the face side of the fabric (marked with red dots on the chart). Make a small bow. Cut off the excess of the tape.
